The Southern Illinois Continuum of Care Network Board of Directors met on August 3, 2017 and voted to accept a modified Monitoring and Evaluation form to be used for ranking purposes. This tool uses System Performance Measurements, reports from HMIS, other information available, and the most recent APRs available. New questions for the instrument and questions that could be eliminated were proposed by the continuum Collaborative Applicant and the grant writer. The accuracy of the HMIS system and the scoring of the HMIS generated information concerned the Board. It was agreed that the instrument would need additional modifications before use in the next cycle. Based on available information and by vote of the Board, the projects were ranked in the same order as last year.
